<u>Climate Pollution Reduction Grants Under the IRA: EPA Guidance for</u> <u>States, Local Governments, Tribes, and Territories</u>

The <u>Climate Pollution Reduction Grants Program</u> (CPRG) was established under Section 60114 of the Inflation Reduction Act, and provides funding to states, local governments, tribes, and territories to develop and implement ambitious plans for reducing greenhouse gas emissions and other harmful air pollution. The Legal Pathways to Deep Decarbonization project is co-sponsoring a <u>January 23, 2024</u> <u>webinar</u> with the New York State Bar Association on how states and local governments can apply for this program effectively.
